

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Ophthalmology Tech Career Ladder

June 2022

The following agreement is between The University of Vermont Medical Center (“UVMCMC”) and Vermont Federation of Nurses and Health Professionals, Local 5221 (“VFNHP”).

The parties agree that the following career ladder will be implemented with the specific skills, experience and competencies detailed on the full job description for each respective job title.

OR Differential

Ophthalmology Technicians who assists surgeons in the Operating Room will receive a differential of \$3.50/hour for every hour worked in this capacity.

Ophthalmic Photographer coverage

When a member of the Ophthalmology staff provides full shift coverage for the Ophthalmic Photographer they will be compensated at the Photographer hourly wage at the covering employee’s current step.

Certification Exam Payment

UVMMC will cover the cost of two certification exam attempts for COT and COMT.

Implementation

This career ladder goes into effect within 30 days following execution of this agreement.

Following implementation, staff meeting the requirements of a new level position on the ladder will be promoted in the next full pay period following a meeting with their supervisor where the requirements and any documentation needed is reviewed. Example would be a copy of a certification.

Any technologist not meeting the certification requirements of their current position will remain in their current position for 12 months, after which they will be placed on the level applicable to their level of certification.

All newly hired technicians will be given a copy of this career ladder.
